

Visa for Spouse or Child of Japanese National living in Palau (Temporary Visit)

A. Eligibility for Applicant

- Spouse/Child (including special adopted child) who lives together with a Japanese who has a long-term visa status and submits a report of residency (Zairyu Todoke) at Embassy in Palau
- For multiple entry visa, should have travel experience to Japan more than once and marriage period more than 1 year

*If the applicant doesn't live together with Japanese spouse/parent, please refer to the requirements for Visiting Relatives/ Acquaintances

B. Requirements

- ① Valid Passport
- ② Visa Application Form
- ③ 1 Photo 2in x 1.4in
- ④ Documents to prove kinship (Marriage certificate or Birth Certificate)
- ⑤ Copy of Japanese spouse or Japanese parent's Passport
- ⑥ Copy of Japanese spouse or Japanese parent's Work Permit or other type of permit issued by the Palau Government
- ⑦ Proof of sufficient funds to defray all the expenses while in Japan
(Main income earner of household)
More than one of the following documents
 - Certificate of Income/Taxation issued by a public agency
 - Certificate of deposit balance (Copy of Bank book or monthly statement, etc)

(For Multiple Entry Visa)

- ⑧ Documents to prove your travel history to Japan (Japan Visa and entry/exit stamp)
- ⑨ A letter explaining the reason for applying for multiple entry visa
- ⑩ Family Registration issued within 3 months (Koseki Tohon) (Omit #④)

[Notice]

- Applicants for multiple entry visa are not permitted to stay in Japan totally for more than (6) months within one (1) year. If applicants wish to stay for longer period of time, it is necessary to obtain a status of residence.
- The applicant may be required to submit additional documents if needed.
