Confirmation slip, certificate, or other documents to prove reservation of air or ship boarding ticket. ☐ 5. Proof of sufficient funds to defray all the expenses while in Japan - Certificate of income or a tax payment issued by a public agency (W-2 Form) 3 months bank statement ☐ 6. Documents to prove kinship (Must be Original) - Visiting Relatives: Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Certified copy of family register, etc. - Visiting acquaintances/Friend: Photo, Letters, E-mails, Bills for international calls, etc. <i>Note: Original Copies can be returned upon request.</i>	
B. Documents prepared by inviting person/guarantor in Japan

C. Documents prepared by guarantor who pays for travel expenses

More than one of the following documents concerning the guarantor *Withholding tax slip will not be accepted. -The latest Certificate of income (the previous year’s gross income must be included)/ taxation issued by the head of administration of the place of residence, or tax return (Form 2) issued by the director of tax office. ☐ 13. Certificate of Residence “Jyuminhyo” (with description of his/her family relationship with all family members) ☐ 14. (When guarantor is a foreign national) Copy of both sides of the valid Residence Card, a Certificate of Residence (with all matters listed except for Individual Number (“My Number”) and <u>Resident Record Code</u>, and A copy of his/her passport (including the pages of status items, records of entry/departure, and permission of residence)
